

**Course Title:** Trados Team – Level 1

**Learning Objectives:** This course is designed for users who want to get familiar with Trados Team to start working productively as soon as possible. Key topics are:

- Overview of the application
- Configuring the application
- Translating files in Trados Team
- Reviewing files in Trados Team
- Working with project templates
- Using machine translation
- Studio and Trados Team
- The Customer Portal

**Target Audience:** This course is for:

- The customer’s team, who want to get a full overview of Trados Team, from system configuration to project creation, translation, and review in Trados Team.

**Prerequisites:** Basic understanding of PCs, the Windows operating system, and MS Word

**Course Delivery Mode:** This course is available in the following delivery modes:

- hands-on and classroom-based, delivered over 1 day
- live and web-based, delivered over 4 hours

**Trados Certification:** This course covers most of the topics that attendees need to pass their Trados Team Level 1 exam.

The Trados™ Certification program enables individual administrators, project managers, translators, and reviewers to validate their knowledge and expertise in the use of Trados products. Achieving Trados Certification demonstrates that you are fully prepared to work with the world’s leading translation technology.

Certification in the Trados Team product can be achieved by taking the following web-based exam:

- Trados Team – Level 1

The exam questions are based on the topics covered in the “Trados Studio – Level 1” course. Attendance on the course followed by practical work to experience the topics covered will prepare attendees to take the exam.

The exam consists of 40 questions and lasts 40 minutes. Training participants will be enrolled in the certification exam on the [Center for Learning](#) platform. To take the exam, attendees log into the Center for Learning, where the exams, training manuals and sample files can be found in the corresponding course.

Attendees are advised immediately on completion of the exam whether they have passed or need to retake it. Attendees have up to three attempts to pass the exam. On successful completion, they receive a link to a digital badge showing that they have passed. The badge is personal and can be used to promote the learner’s status, e.g., in their email signatures, website, etc.

**Further Development:**

At the end of this course, attendees will understand how to configure the system and how to work with projects.
